



STATE OF NEVADA BOARD OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

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CAN I REINSTATE MY EXPIRED NEVADA LICENSE?

ELIGIBILITY FOR REINSTATEMENT OF ACTIVE LICENSE

An individual who held an **active license** in Nevada that expired within the previous five (5) years, may request reinstatement of their Active License. An applicant must have current NBCOT certification.

An Applicant whose license has been expired for more than five (5) years must apply as a new licensee.

Required Documentation and Information

Completed Application for License Reinstatement - Applications must be completed in full and must be signed and dated.

NBCOT Certificate - You must provide a copy of your current NBCOT certification.

Continuing Education - You must submit with your application, completed continuing education form(s) and certificates of attendance or completion to support the continuing education listed on your application. A minimum of 10 hours earned within the last 12 months is required.

Verification of Licensure in Another State – Submit verification form directly to regulatory entities of all jurisdictions in which you have held a license in the **previous 5 years**. Verification must be received directly from the regulatory entity.

Verification of Employment and Supervision – Required for COTA applicants only. Completed form must be submitted within 15 days from start of employment in Nevada.

Reinstatement Fee—Payment must be submitted at time of application. Applications that are received without payment are incomplete and will be returned to the applicant. Fees may be paid by credit card through our website, www.nvot.org, Click to Pay, or by check or money order payable to the “Board of Occupational Therapy”.
