USE OF PROFESSIONAL TITLE

NAC 640A.200

An occupational therapist or occupational therapy assistant shall not use a title or initials for a title that are misleadingly similar to a title or certification, or initials for a title or certification, that he has not earned.

Occupational Therapist

An occupational therapist shall, in all appropriate professional circumstances, refer to himself professionally as an “occupational therapist”, “licensed occupational therapist”, an “occupational therapist licensed” or by the title’s initials, including “OT/L”.

Certified Occupational Therapist

If an occupational therapist has current certification from NBCOT, he may refer to himself professionally as an “occupational therapist registered”, an “occupational therapist registered licensed”, “ or by the title’s initials, “OTR” or “OTR/L”.

Occupational Therapy Assistant

An occupational therapy assistant shall, in all appropriate professional circumstances, refer to himself professionally as an “occupational therapy assistant”, “licensed occupational therapy assistant”, an “occupational therapy assistant licensed” or by the title’s initials, including “OTA/L”.

Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant

If an occupational therapy assistant has current certification from NBCOT, he may refer to himself professionally as a “certified occupational therapy assistant”, “certified occupational therapy assistant licensed”, “ or by the title’s initials, “COTA” or “COTA/L”.
