On May 7, 2026, Mr. Buenviaje was issued a Cease and Desist. Mr. Buenviaje has been practicing without a license during the period of January 6, 2025 to May 5, 2026 and was provided notice to appear before the Board for a determination of whether to assess an **administrative fine** for practicing without a valid license pursuant to NRS 640A.230.

NRS 640A.230 Unauthorized practice prohibited; penalties.

1. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 629.091, a person shall not practice occupational therapy, or represent that he or she is authorized to practice occupational therapy, in this state unless he or she holds a current license issued pursuant to this chapter. A person who violates the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
 2. In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, if the Board determines that a person has violated the provisions of subsection 1, the Board may:
 - (a) Issue and serve on the person an order to cease and desist until the person obtains from the Board the proper license or otherwise demonstrates that he or she is no longer in violation of subsection 1. An order to cease and desist must include a telephone number with which the person may contact the Board.
 - (b) Issue a citation to the person. A citation issued pursuant to this paragraph must be in writing, describe with particularity the nature of the violation and inform the person of the provisions of this paragraph. Each activity in which the person is engaged constitutes a separate offense for which a separate citation may be issued. To appeal a citation, the person must submit a written request for a hearing to the Board not later than 30 days after the date of issuance of the citation.
 - (c) Assess against the person an administrative fine of not more than \$5,000.
 - (d) Impose any combination of the penalties set forth in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c).

Hello Ms. Whittaker,

Thank you for your email and for the opportunity to clarify.

To answer your first question, I do not currently hold, and have not previously held, a state license to practice Occupational Therapy in any other state or jurisdiction. My credential has been my NBCOT certification.

Regarding the professional sanctions question, that was made in error during the application process and was corrected to “No.” I have not had any professional sanctions, disciplinary actions, investigations, suspensions, revocations, or restrictions against any professional license or certification.

I would also like to provide full disclosure regarding my current situation. I recently became aware that NBCOT certification alone was not sufficient to practice occupational therapy in Nevada and that a separate Nevada Board of Occupational Therapy license was required. This was an honest but serious misunderstanding and oversight on my part. I am deeply sorry for this mistake, and I take full responsibility for correcting it.

By way of background, I passed my NBCOT examination in approximately October/November 2024. At that time, I understood there was an option to have my NBCOT results/verification sent to the state where I intended to practice. I selected Nevada and mistakenly believed that this completed what was needed for Nevada. I now understand that I was mistaken and that I still needed to complete the separate Nevada Board licensure process.

I began working in a school-based occupational therapy setting as a contractor on or about January 6, 2025. During onboarding and credentialing with my contracting company, I submitted the documents that were requested of me, including my NBCOT certification and identification. I also double-checked with the credentialing team to ask whether I had submitted all required forms and whether anything else was needed. I was cleared by the credentialing team based on the documents I provided, and at the time, I believed I had completed the requirements needed to begin working.

After May 2025, I applied for and accepted a full-time occupational therapy position directly with the school district. I began full-time employment on or about July 31, 2025. During that onboarding and credentialing process, I again submitted the requested documentation, including my NBCOT certification and identification, and I understood that I had completed the required credentialing steps.

I became aware of the Nevada licensure issue on Friday when I tried to apply for a summer position and saw that the position strictly required a Nevada OT license. I then checked the Nevada Board website and searched using my NBCOT number, but my name did not appear. This prompted me to immediately submit my Nevada OT license application and to fully disclose/report the situation.

As you can see in my application, I included my current employment information to show full transparency. I did not want to omit or hide anything from the Board.

I want to sincerely apologize for this oversight. I did not intentionally misrepresent my credentials or knowingly withhold information, but I understand that intent does not remove my responsibility to know and follow the licensure requirements for the state where I practice. I care deeply about this profession, my role as an occupational therapist, and the students and families I serve. This career means a great deal to me, and I am very remorseful that my misunderstanding placed me in this situation.

I am acting in good faith by bringing this matter forward, and I willfully acknowledge my negligence in not confirming the separate Nevada licensure requirement before beginning practice. I understand that this was my responsibility as the practitioner, and I am not attempting to avoid accountability. My goal is to be fully transparent, cooperate with the Board, and take whatever corrective steps are required.

Around the time I passed my board examination and was trying to begin working, my father-in-law had a stroke and my wife was diagnosed with a high-risk pregnancy with our first child. I understand these circumstances do not excuse my responsibility, but I share this context because this was a complete oversight during a very stressful time in my personal life. I was a new therapist and recent graduate trying to begin my first OT position, and I mistakenly believed I had completed the proper steps.

I fully take responsibility for this error and sincerely ask for grace and guidance as I work to correct the situation. I became an occupational therapist because I want to help others, especially children, and because I believe in the value and purpose of occupational therapy. I respect this profession and the Nevada Board's role in protecting the public and maintaining professional standards. I do not want to hide anything, and I am willing to provide any additional information or documentation that may be needed.

Out of caution, I have stopped providing OT services after today while this matter is being addressed. I am also working on informing my employer of the situation and taking the appropriate steps to correct this.

Please advise me regarding what I should do next. I would also appreciate the opportunity to discuss this matter by phone, virtual meeting, or in person if possible. I can be reached at [REDACTED].

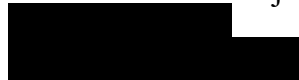

Re: Notice to Cease and Desist

Dear Mr. Buenviaje,

You are hereby ordered to Cease and Desist the practice of Occupational Therapy until such a time as your initial application has been approved.

The Board received your initial application for a standard Occupational Therapist license on May 2, 2026. On your application, you indicated that you were hired as an occupational therapist on or about January 6, 2025 by Orange Tree Staffing as a contractor for Clark County School District. You also indicated that you were employed on or about July 30, 2025 as an occupational therapist for Clark County School District.

NRS 640A.050 “Occupational therapy” defined. “Occupational therapy” means the use of evaluations, teachings and interventions to facilitate the activities of daily living of a client in groups or on an individual basis to enable the client to participate in and perform activities of daily living in various settings, including, without limitation, at home, at school, in the workplace and in the community.

Please be advised, the practice of Occupational Therapy without a current license is a violation of the Nevada Occupational Therapy law, NRS 640A.230 which reads:

NRS 640A.230 Unauthorized practice prohibited; penalties.

1. Except as otherwise provided in [NRS 629.091](#), a person shall not practice occupational therapy, or represent that he or she is authorized to practice occupational therapy, in this state unless he or she holds a current license issued pursuant to this chapter. A person who violates the provisions of this subsection is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

2. In addition to any other penalty prescribed by law, if the Board determines that a person has violated the provisions of subsection 1, the Board may:

(a) Issue and serve on the person an order to cease and desist until the person obtains from the Board the proper license or otherwise demonstrates that he or she is no longer in violation of

subsection 1. An order to cease and desist must include a telephone number with which the person may contact the Board.

(b) Issue a citation to the person. A citation issued pursuant to this paragraph must be in writing, describe with particularity the nature of the violation and inform the person of the provisions of this paragraph. Each activity in which the person is engaged constitutes a separate offense for which a separate citation may be issued. To appeal a citation, the person must submit a written request for a hearing to the Board not later than 30 days after the date of issuance of the citation.

(c) Assess against the person an administrative fine of not more than \$5,000.

(d) Impose any combination of the penalties set forth in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c).

Licensure Statistics - The following chart provides current licensing details and activity as of March 31, 2026 through May 15, 2026.

Current Statistics

New Applications Received:	32	Licenses Issued:	32
Licenses Expired:	7	Licenses Renewed:	158

There are 1,457 OTs and 455 OTAs for a total of 1,912 licensees.

Office Operations & Activities - Disciplinary reporting has been submitted to NBCOT, AOTA, and NPDB.

Proposed Regulation of the Commission on Professional Standards in Education – Regulation LCB File No. R102-25 establishes that occupational therapist must hold a license with the OT Board and have a master’s degree or higher in occupational therapy to receive an endorsement to provide services to pupils. Director Briske has sent the Board’s Office a copy of the redraft of the regulations. The redraft now indicates that occupational therapists must hold a license with the OT Board and have a bachelor’s degree or higher in occupational therapy to receive an endorsement.

Department of Business and Industry – Regulation LCB File No. R074-25 has been created under NRS 232.8415 to streamline boards and commissions. A public workshop for review of the draft regulations was held on November 25, 2025. The second public workshop to solicit comments on the proposed regulations was held on March 31, 2026. The Office of Nevada Boards, Commissions, and Councils Standards held a hearing on May 11, 2026. The regulations were adopted as presented at the hearing on May 11, 2026.

Adopted Regulation LCB File No. R094-25 – The Board adopted the regulation at their meeting on March 21, 2026. The adopted regulation has been submitted to LCB to be placed on the agenda for the Legislative Commission meeting scheduled for June 30, 2026 for review and approval.

Big Picture/Albertson Consulting – Big Picture has begun work on the Board’s website to meet ADA Compliance.

Complaints Status - There are currently four complaints in the investigation phase.
